## New Interviews

This issue describes **six new interviews** that are available on our Web site.

**OH 1468V. Clyde Martz** responds to questions about his career and accomplishments as professor of natural resource law at the University of Colorado, 1947 to 1972. Martz also shares stories relating to his education, service in World War II, marriage, employment in the Interior Department during the Carter administration, and work at the Rocky Mountain Mineral Institute.
